Job Announcement – Customer Services Engineer

The Customer Services Engineer is responsible for providing support to Platte River and its member municipalities in the areas of demand side management (DSM), energy services and renewable energy. DSM support is focused toward project management, program evaluation and marketing of existing programs, as well as research, evaluation and design of new programs. Energy services are provided for Platte River, the municipalities and their customers, including energy audits, power quality assessments, new construction and retrofit design review and distributed generation analysis. Renewable energy program tasks include operation of the Medicine Bow Wind Project, municipality and customer program services and support for planning and acquisition of new renewable sources. Depending on the specific application of services, support is provided directly or through interaction with other service providers (vendors, consultants, designers, contractors, etc.).

Required qualifications include a Bachelor's degree in engineering from an accredited four-year institution and at least one year of experience in demand side management or energy services, preferably in the electric utility industry. Excellent interpersonal skills, written/verbal communication skills and organization/planning skills are also required. The successful candidate would report to the Division Manager of Customer Services and would work closely with an experienced Customer Service Engineer and other energy services, marketing and environmental services staff. He/she must be able to work cooperatively in a team environment, managing multiple tasks on a variety of projects. Thorough knowledge of PC based software including Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, Access and PowerPoint) is required. Regular attendance is also required.

Desirable qualifications include on-site experience with commercial customers and facilities, preferably in this region, familiarity with energy use monitoring methods and equipment, project experience (construction, equipment procurement, energy services, contracting, etc.), energy analysis/modeling experience and energy program marketing experience.
